

LYME DISEASE IS IN BC!

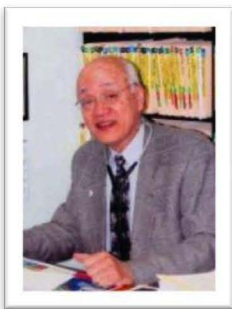


What is Lyme Disease and how is it relevant to me or my patients?

The Public Health Agency of Canada has identified Vancouver Island, the Lower Mainland, and the Fraser Valley specifically as "Lyme Disease Endemic Areas." The spectrum of symptoms that may indicate a Lyme or Tick Borne Infection (TBI) and how to evaluate and treat them will be covered in this session. TBIs have a major impact on the immune and nervous systems and significantly impact quality of life.

Discussion will include Lyme Awareness in BC, Prevention, Proper tick removal technique, symptoms, treatment and more! Q and A will follow.
